## **GRADUATION EVENTS**

By 4:00 p.m. or earlier on Friday, we expect that all Seniors will depart from campus to allow the School to get back to the academic work of the second semester for the remaining students. Seniors will be asked to pack their belongings in the days prior to Graduation, and once final goodbyes are over, please finish packing and leave behind an empty, clean dormitory room. Seniors should not return to campus while School remains in session.

## FINAL ITEMS

Spring is an incredibly busy time at Hotchkiss, especially in the lead-up to and during Graduation week. Seniors are constantly traveling on and off campus to visit with family and friends during these final days. It is important to note that all Major School Rules remain in effect for all Seniors until after they leave campus following Commencement. For the safety and well-being of your children, I encourage you to take an active role in planning or approving your own graduate's post-Commencement plans.
